

Job description for the positions of Research Assistants and Research Associates

Roles and responsibilities associated with these positions are outlined below.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Contribution to the implementation / execution of research projects (including review of literature, collection of data, conduct of field work, analysis of data and report writing).
- Contribution to writing of research proposals
- Contribution to organizational activities such as recruitment and selection of interns and organizational communication
- Contribution to writing and publication of journal articles / newspaper articles / highimpact blogs.

Apart from fulfilling these responsibilities, selected candidate are expected to actively collaborate within teams and participate in various capacity building initiatives undertaken for enhancement of skill sets. They are expected to contribute to organizational development activities, as required.

The following are the required qualifications and skill sets:

- Masters in Economics / Statistics / Development Economics, Public Policy/ Sociology/ Development Studies and related disciplines.
- Knowledge and understanding of qualitative and quantitative research methods.
- Knowledge and interest in social science and policy research / public finance and governance / education / gender / livelihoods / health and nutrition and related areas.

Preferred skill sets:

- Knowledge of Excel and proficiency in handling large data sets in MS Excel
- Knowledge of econometrics with experience of working on Stata or similar packages such as R
- Knowledge of qualitative data analysis software such as NVivo and Atlas.ti
- Ability to work in multi-disciplinary teams.
