Why Tracer Study?

To know the career trajectory of learners who have completed their course from NIOS.

Did NIOS course facilitated their current venture?



Methods Used

- Survey: Andhra Pradesh, Rajasthan and Delhi (majority of ODL learners are based in Delhi).
- Telephonic Interviews based on random sampling.
- Sample: Learners completed 2008 to 2012.
- Diary writing.

Male Respondents

- Total no of calls=3703
- Successful respondent=693
- Response rate=19%

Female Respondents

- Total no of calls=1944
- Successful respondent=260
- Response rate=13%



Profile of Respondents

- Male 72.8%
- General caste- 55.6%
- Age-wise enrolment: Males: 24-30 years (41%)

Females - 19-24 years (38%)




Career Trajectory

Senior Secondary – 64%



Students =29% Employed=23% Self Employed=6% Unemployed=40%






Distribution of Female Respondents
